Research Program: Latin and bilingual (Latin-Greek) epistolography on papyrus. Material and linguistic-literary surveys.

Description of the Research Program: The post-doctoral researcher will serve as 'Research Assistant' (RA) of the project and will work closely with the Principal Investigator of PLATINUM. He/she will be responsible for the Research Program duties and for organizational tasks related to the scientific part of PLATINUM. The RA will assist the PI in searching for and establishing links with papyrological collections and additional Research Groups, as well as in managing the scientific activities of the project.

He/she will work on Latin and bilingual (Latin-Greek) letters on papyrus, parchment scraps and *ostraka* between 1st cent. B.C. and 6th cent. A.D. A material (i.e. palaeographical-papyrological) analysis of the texts will precede the linguistic and literary examination. His/her first months of employment will be spent working towards a first census of Latin (but also bilingual and trilingual, when Latin is attested) texts on papyrus, together with the other members of the staff. He/she will also oversee the implementation of the online platform of PLATINUM.
